Art historian and Venice resident Dr Susan Steer leads this tour, which includes private evening visits to the Palazzo Albrizzi and to the Basilica di San Marco, and tours of the lesser-visited Ghetto and Cannaregio district, as well as access to areas of the Palazzo Ducale that are normally closed.

From £2,710 (pp, two sharing) includes return LGW flights, 4* hotel, travel by motoscafo & vaporetto, most meals with drinks and visits. Departs 13th November 2018 (6 days).

[Venetian Palaces](#)

Visits many of Venice's finest and best-preserved palaces, home to some of the city's wealthiest nobles and merchants, many of which are still in private hands. Includes a private, out-of-hours visit to the Basilica di San Marco.

This wide-ranging survey of painting, sculpture and architecture, with an emphasis on the Renaissance, is led by Venice resident Dr Susan Steer. Suitable for first-time and return visitors to Venice, this tour also includes a private, evening visit to the Basilica di San Marco.
